Dear School Community,

WCS is committed to the safety and health of our students and staff. We want to inform you that we have recently received information about a confirmed case of COVID-19 in a student or staff member at Wilmington High School. You will receive a separate notification if your child is in the same classroom as the individual that has a confirmed case. Cleaning and disinfecting of any exposed locations have been completed.

We are working closely with the Clinton County Health District and anyone identified as a close contact will be notified by the health department as a part of COVID-19 investigation. If you do not receive a call from the health department, your child was not found to be in close contact.
